



The search page

Use this page to select the options you wish to search by.

There are two methods of searching:

- Click on 'A-Z of organisations' to search for a particular organisation
- Use the search filters and/or keywords to search for organisations that may provide the type of activity or support you are looking for

Using the search filters

Click on one or more of the down arrows and then click on the option of your choice.

Select a sport, disability, age range or town to find organisations in your area that may be able to provide the activities you are looking for. If your search is unsuccessful try widening your search to other areas, or select 'any age'.

You can search by authority area or county to find out what's available in a wider geographic area.

Using the keyword searches

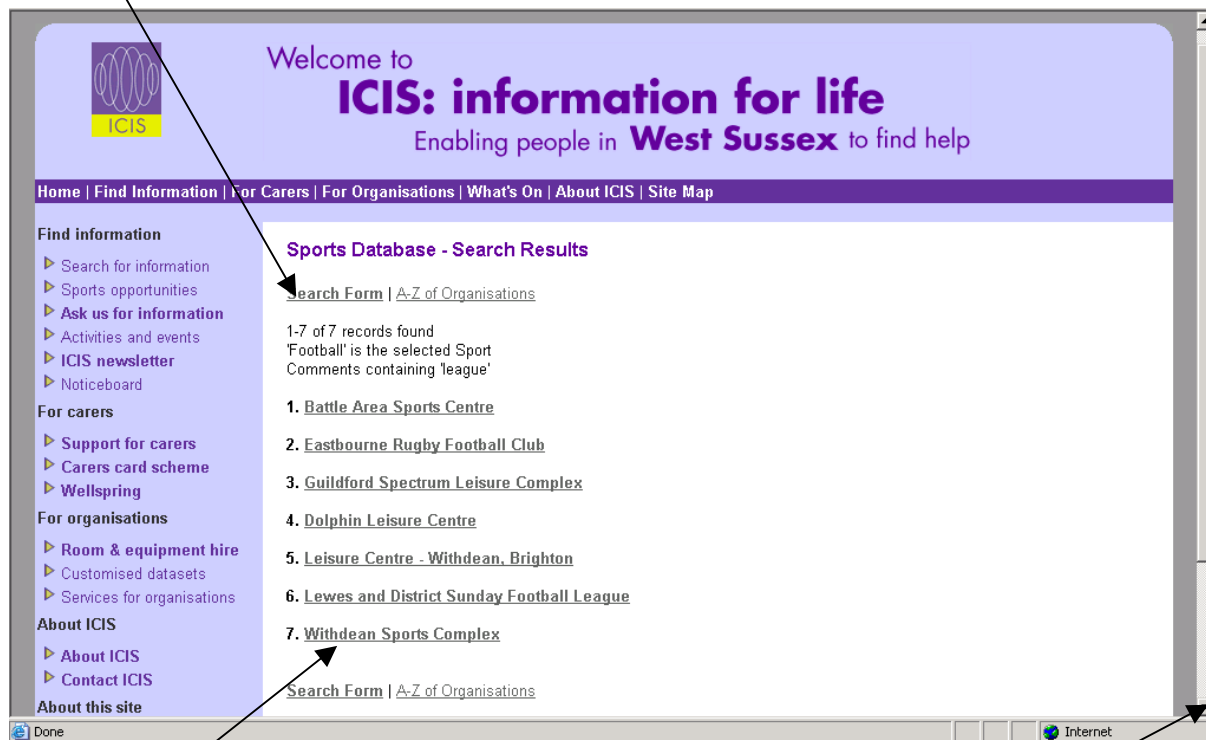
You can search by a keyword either in the description of the organisation, or the organisation name. For instance, a search for 'Football' and keyword in comments 'league', will produce only records for football contacts with 'league' in the comments field.

Having selected your options, click Search.

The results page

This is the page that lists the results of your search. The page details how many records have been found, and the search criteria you have used. Some organisations may be known by alternative names and will appear twice in the list.




Click on an organisation to view further details

This page displays the details of the organisation selected.


